Tender Document	11	General		<p>We are kindly requesting you to postpone the tender on 15th December because Appendix A8 is not acceptable from any prestigious subcontractors due to the conditions that do not comply with international law and the concepts and meanings that are not fully explained legally.</p> <p>Since we can only participate in the tender with a subcontractor, the principle of equality between the bidders has been violated due to the Appendix A8, which we claim is against international law and cannot be accepted by any serious subcontractor. For this reason, we need time to create a change request on Appendix A8 and to conclude an acceptable contract with our Sub-contractor on the principle of mutual exchange.</p> <p>Or to make just minor changes to the appendix A8 of your contract.</p> <p>to transfer the responsibility of the job to the bidder instead to put all the pressure on the subcontractor.</p> <p>We believing that we will give the best and economical price in the tender, we submit that this situation is in the interests of Israel</p>	<p>The Tender Committee rejects this request. Firstly, request was made after the final date for submitting questions and request for changes and thus cannot be considered. Secondly, Tender Committee has drafted the pre-requisite in order to extend the potential of competition whilst maintaining and ensuring the professional capability if such bidders. Upon bidders request, the Tender Committee has redrafted such conditions. Tender Committee has allowed bidders to lean on the experience of sub-contractors as detailed in the Tender Document. However, such leaning is subject to sub-contractor taking responsibility for its Works and not disappearing after the bidder has been nominated as the winner bidder.</p>
